Opening night took an unexpected turn when one of the lead actors, Gideon Henry, playing lover boy Lysander, suffered a broken leg on stage, forcing a premature end to the night's show. Gideon has since received medical care and is recovering at home. He is a beloved member of the team and is determined to be in the audience for the final show this Sunday – and for the after party, of course!

In the face of such a major setback, our cast and crew rallied with extraordinary resilience and care. Everyone returned on Saturday and Sunday determined to honour the work, the audience and each other. Director Mikey has stepped seamlessly into the role of Lysander. Thanks to their professionalism, commitment and courage,

they delivered two incredible performances, showcasing the talent of the actors as well as the creativity and craftsmanship of the whole team behind the scenes.


We're immensely proud of our team, grateful to audiences for their understanding and support, and can't wait to bring three more shows to the stage this Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

Meet Mikey! Mikey began performing when he was nine years old. From Speech and Drama to local shows and theatre, he fell in love with it.

He has previously performed in several productions with Bathurst Shakespeare Players at Abercrombie House, including *Twelfth Night*, *Comedy of Errors*, and *The Tempest*. One of his most memorable roles to date was as Mercutio in *Romeo & Juliet*.

Mikey is a recent addition to Bathurst Theatre Company, first joining in 2024 for his role in Phil Sanders' *Another Openin'* as Mr Gollinge after hearing about the group through social media and through recommendations from other local thespians.

Outside the theatre, Mikey manages a courier company, but his true passions lie in the creative world. In his free time, he is a Games Master who runs many different Tabletop Role Playing Games. He builds and paints models, writes screenplays and short stories, and creates cosplays.

Mikey is a newly elected BTC Board Member and is also the co-director of BTC's 2025 production of *A Midsummer Night's Dream*. The idea to direct a Shakespeare play grew from early conversations with co-director Bethany, back when they worked together on *Macbeth* in 2018. Now, with *AMND* entering its final week, he couldn't be happier with what the cast and crew have created together.

For anyone thinking about joining BTC next year, Mikey's advice is simple: "Please, please, please, approach BTC with your ideas. The ability to open up a conversation about creating a show or an event is extremely possible with the helpful team at BTC."




Wanted!




